TIPS TO GET YOUR HOME READY FOR A PHOTOSHOOT

Your online listing creates a first impression that will help a potential buyer decide to request a showing. Here's how to make it the best it can be!

- 1. **Pull cars out of the driveway** and out of the line of sight from the front windows, if possible.
- 2. Garbage cans should not be visible in front or back of house .
- 3. Remove all outside clutter like childrens toys and gardening tools.
- 4. Mow the lawn within 24 hours of the shoot (if during growing season)
- 5. Declutter all surfaces especially kitchen and bathroom countertops (sponges/washcloths, toothbrushes, cups, kleenex boxes, medications, etc).
- 6. Toilet seats down.
- 7. ALL lights on, all fans off (inside and out!)
- 8. Hide pet bowls/beds/toys.
- 9. Remove stickers and/or magnets from refrigerator.
- **10.** All window blinds at 90-degree angle.
- 11. Remove all toys and clothing from floors and surfaces.
- 12. Vacuum and Dust. If possible, clean windows it makes a BIG difference!

NEED A LITTLE EXTRA HELP?

- It's better to have a "sacrifice room" where you stash extra stuff than to have a lot of clutter in each room.
- If your under cabinet space is full and you can't declutter counter tops, fill a cardboard box or laundry basket that can be stashed in another room for the photos.
- Don't worry about your closets or garages. Unless they're unique and/or fabulous, we probably won't take photos of them.
